# EES Marching Band Guidelines Beginning July 20, 2020

<u>All participation in rehearsals shall be voluntary and students choosing not to participate</u> <u>shall not have that held against them as it relates to participation in marching band in the</u> <u>future.</u>

## Facilities Cleaning

- Prior to an individual or groups of individuals entering the designated bathrooms, hard surfaces within that facility will be wiped down and sanitized.
  - Band staff will receive training in the proper method of cleaning and disinfecting the designated restrooms.
- Equipment that absolutely must be shared (certain percussion items) will be wiped down thoroughly with school-supplied sanitizing wipes before and after an individual's use of such equipment by trained band staff.
- Disposable gloves will be provided for the movement of percussion equipment to/from the rehearsal area.

## Entrance/Exit Strategies

- A separate entrance and exit shall be utilized in accordance with the plan developed by the District Director of Bands.
- Band staff shall require students to leave school grounds when the rehearsal is complete. Loitering or congregating on school grounds after the rehearsal is discouraged.

#### Limitations on Gatherings

- No gathering of more than 50 people at a time.
- Student breaks will be conducted in "pods" of students with the same 5-10 students together to limit overall exposures.
- There must be a minimum distance of 6 feet between each individual (10' feet for trombones) at all times.
- All gatherings shall be conducted outdoors.
  - During inclimate weather students will utilize pre designated areas within the buildings in coordination with the district facilities coordinator. All students/staff will wear face coverings and stay in their designated "pods." No practicing will be done indoors at this time.

#### Pre-rehearsal Screening

- All staff and students shall wear face coverings during the pre-screening assessment.
  - After passing the screening, students will be given a ziplock bag to store their mask during rehearsal. It will be stored with their personal belongings such as an instrument case or backpack.
- A roster of all students and staff present during the rehearsal shall be completed and shall be submitted to the Director of bands for <u>each</u> rehearsal conducted. One rehearsal per roster.

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- All staff and students shall be screened daily for signs/symptoms of COVID-19 prior to participating, including a temperature check and responding to required screening questions. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 degrees or above shall not participate and be sent home. Anyone who answers ``yes" to any of the screening questions, shall not participate and must be sent home.
- Individuals shall wash their hands for a minimum of 20 seconds with warm water and soap or hand sanitizer before touching any surfaces or participating in workouts.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided and located at check-in.
- Responses to screening questions for each person shall be recorded and stored.
- Any person with positive symptoms reported shall not be allowed to participate, should self-isolate, and contact their primary care provider or other health-care professional.
- Vulnerable individuals should not supervise or participate in any rehearsals.
- Appropriate clothing/shoes should be worn at all times to minimize sweat from transmitting onto equipment/surfaces.

## Face Coverings

- Staff, officials and other contest personnel shall wear face coverings at all times
- Students participating in rehearsals may wear face coverings.
- Cloth face coverings should be considered acceptable.
- Plastic shields covering the entire face will not be allowed during participation due to the risk of unintended injury to the person wearing the shield or others.

#### **Hygiene Practices**

- Wash your hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer, especially after touching frequently used items or surfaces. Hand sanitizer located at the check-in area.
- Sneeze or cough into a tissue, or the inside of your elbow. Avoid touching your face.
- Students must be encouraged to shower and wash their rehearsal clothing immediately upon returning to home.

## Hydration/Food

- All students must bring their own water bottle. Water bottles must not be shared.
- Students will either bring food or receive food prepared by district personnel. Meal breaks will be given in their assigned "pods" of students with the same 5-10 students together to limit overall exposures. Food must not be shared.
- Hydration stations (water cows, water trough, water fountains, etc.) should not be utilized therefore students should be encouraged to bring extra water.
